## Nearly 9 in 10 voters feel that there should be another round on COVID-19 relief from Congress.

Support is so strong for another round of COVID-19 relief legislation from Congress that every type of subgroup, voter group, and region supports it.

## Eight out of ten (79\%) say that we must work together to find common ground. Biden and Trump voters concur.
